WEEK 1 -WELCOME TO THE GREAT SOUTHERN REEF

The Great Southern Reef is Australia's hidden treasure, a marine wonderland that rivals even the Great Barrier Reef in its beauty and biodiversity.

Imagine diving into the cool waters of the Great Southern Reef and encountering an underwater forest of towering kelp, home to playful seals and dolphins. Or exploring the rocky reefs and discovering colourful sponges, anemones, and corals.

Well now you can – from the comfort of our classroom! Students will utilise the Great Southern Reef live camera stream and Virtual Reality Headsets to conduct a biodiversity assessment of Popes Eye and support Victoria National Parks Association annual fish count.

WEEK 2-MICROPLASTIC SURVEY

Are you ready to embark on a scientific adventure?

Join the AUSMAP microplastic sampling project and help map the distribution of microplastics in Australian coastal waters! As a citizen scientist, you'll get the chance to investigate the Queenscliff foreshore and conduct a microplastic survey using an array of scientific equipment.

But your work doesn't stop there - the data you collect will be shared with AUSMAP, who will use it to create a comprehensive microplastic hotspot map. Your efforts will also inform policy and management decisions, and help identify areas where action is needed to reduce the amount of plastic entering the marine environment.
